## **Transportation**

We are looking at short term and long term goals on re-paving municipal road. We are looking at Water Oak and Loves Chapel/Hwy 200. We also have water problems at River Rd and Love Chapel. We are looking at every other year of repaving. We will continue to look at the streets and repave the worst ones. Jason Smith wanted to get everyone's opinion about looking at Railroad Ave extending all the way through to Wade Love Lane. Jason Smith ask if anyone seen any more important roads that look bad to let him know.

## **Parks & Recreation**

Jason Smith has come up with an SYAA agreement along with a check list for all ball team groups. (See attached).

**Jason Smith made a motion to accept this new SYAA agreement, all were in favor, motion carried. Mayor Kevin Barbee signed the agreement.**

The fence has been put up, and we will be putting up signs for individuals to stay off fence, and to stay off the walls.

Jason Smith is also looking at borders/mulch around the playground area. We will find out the correct amount of mulch for safety reasons. We are looking at bleachers for the ball field # 2, and we also have ordered safety bases; a child did get hurt last year. Rock climbing wall has been put on hold. James Griffin suggested about having grass in the inside field. We also received some benches that will be installed shortly.

## **Water & Sewer**

Jerry Williams presented information about septic tank versus hooking onto the town sewer, and the cost of each over time.

Jerry Williams would like for the board to consider purchasing a 4-wheel drive truck for the maintenance department in the 2015-2016 budget year. The past couple of weeks when we have bad weather, we don't have a 4-wheel drive to get in and out from the pump station and around. Jerry Williams has been pricing vehicles, and he will come back to the board with some quotes. Jerry Williams also mentioned that all 3 maintenance men can re-build sewer grinder pumps. Jason Smith had positive comments about our 3 maintenance men working on our own equipment. They have been utilizing their time in the shop when it has been raining.
